### Programs

- K–5 Core + Project–Based Learning — Literacy, math, science, and social studies aligned to Florida standards, taught through hands–on projects and frequent growth checks.
- Individualized Learning (ILPs) — Personal learning plans, data–driven small groups, and goal–setting conferences across literacy, math, science, and social studies.
- Performing Arts & Spanish Enrichment — Weekly music, theatre, visual arts, and daily Spanish exposure tied to our Culture Days.
- Character & Leadership — Social–emotional learning, service projects, and mentorship to build integrity, responsibility, and teamwork.

### Services (with access steps)

- **Academic Support (Tutoring)** — Small–group intervention and enrichment (“What I Need” blocks) based on ongoing assessments.
  - **Access:** Ask your child’s teacher or email [alecia.brightimagnations@gmail.com](mailto:alecia.brightimagnations@gmail.com) to request a review; supports scheduled within 2 weeks of referral.
- **Extended Day & Clubs** — After–school care plus arts/STEM clubs and seasonal showcases.
  - **Access:** Enroll via the Parent Portal or the front office by the 15th of each month; limited seats.
- **Family Support & Language Access** — Interpreter services, translated vital documents, counseling referrals, and Step Up scholarship assistance.

- **Mentoring & Leadership Advisories** — One–on–one or small–group check–ins focused on goals, habits, and transitions (elementary → adulthood).
  - **Access:** Parents/teachers can request additional mentoring by contacting [alecia.brightimagnations@gmail.com](mailto:alecia.brightimagnations@gmail.com) | **(407) 928–8511**. Meetings occur biweekly (more often by request).

### Teacher Qualifications

- Special skills, knowledge, or expertise that qualifies them to provide instruction in K–12th grade subjects
