Our uniform policy helps create a calm, consistent, and focused environment where students can thrive academically and socially—while also building confidence and a strong sense of identity within our school community.



Purpose

At Bright Imaginations Preparatory Schools, our uniform policy is designed to:

- Promote a sense of belonging and school pride
- Minimize distractions and support a focused learning environment
- Ensure equity and simplicity for all families
- Reflect the professionalism and excellence of our school community



Uniform Requirements

- Uniform tops or dresses must be worn every day.
- Uniform bottoms must be worn daily.
- Learners may wear jeans on Fridays.
- Our goal is to ensure that all students feel comfortable, confident, and free to fully participate in all school activities throughout the day.

Uniform Bottom Requirements

All bottoms must be school-appropriate in length (mid-thigh or longer).

Learners may wear any of the following styles, as long as they are within the approved color palette:

- Pants & Shorts
- Skirts & Skorts
- Jumpers

If the uniform bottoms have a belt loop, a black, brown or blue belt is required



Uniform Top Requirements

Uniform tops are required to be collared polo shirts in approved school colors, with the BIP school logo embroidered on the garment.



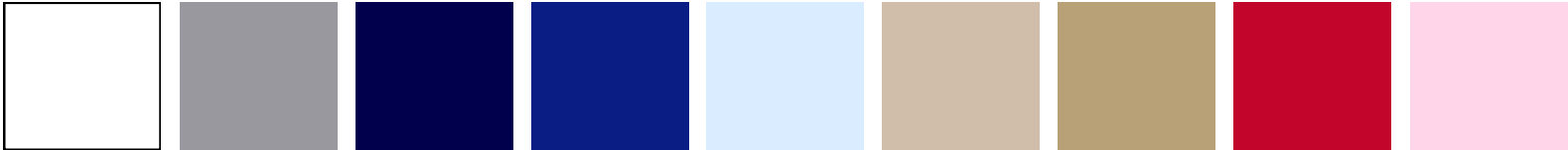
Uniform polos may be purchased from any retailer, provided they meet the approved color guidelines. All shirts must be embroidered with the BIP logo through one of our approved vendors. Approved vendors also offer polos available for direct purchase. Tops can be short or long sleeve.



Girl uniform guidelines

Our goal is to ensure that all students feel comfortable, confident, and free to fully participate in all school activities throughout the day.

- Shorts must be worn underneath all skirts and dresses for comfort, modesty, and ease of movement throughout the school day
- Leggings or tights may be worn underneath skirts or dresses and must be solid uniform colors
- Dresses may be any style, provided they are in approved uniform colors and meet school guidelines for length (mid-thigh or longer)
- Dresses must display the BIP logo when the style allows. If the dress does not accommodate embroidery, a collared shirt worn underneath must feature the BIP logo.



Outerwear

- Solid Navy, Gray, or Black sweaters, cardigans, or light jackets
- Outerwear must have the BIP logo embroidered

Cold Weather

- Learners may wear long sleeves under uniform shirts
- Leggings may be worn under skirts/dresses if they are solid uniform colors

Footwear

- Closed-toe shoes required at all times
- Sneakers or uniform shoes recommended
- Sandals, Crocs, and open-toe shoes are not permitted for safety reasons
